Six Months Research Training Programme in Biotechnology

Applications are invited for the six months research training programme from the students of 4 year Graduate Degrees / PG in Sciences from Universities/ Institutions/ Colleges of repute to carry out their project work towards partial fulfilment of their degrees commencing from January 2016 (January . June 2016). The training programme for Post graduate students of professional courses can be considered for a duration of one year, based on availability of vacancies. The terms and conditions would be as given below:

1. The request should be forwarded through Heads of Departments/ Colleges/ Institutions where the student is presently studying.(The letters may be addressed to the Registrar)
2. The candidates must have passed all examinations starting from secondary school examination in first division or equivalent grade (at least 60% of marks).
3. The candidates will have to make their own local arrangements for stay and other logistics. RCB will not bear any liability whatsoever.
4. They will not be entitled to any remuneration, stipend or fellowship/ assistance in any form during the project period.
5. They will abide by the conduct & rules applicable to the scholars/ employees of the RCB.

Applications/nominations for the training session from interested eligible students through their respective Colleges/Universities/Institutions should reach to **“Office of the Registrar, Regional Centre for Biotechnology, NCR Biotech Science Cluster, 3rd Milestone, Village Bhankri, Faridabad- Gurgaon Expressway, Faridabad- 121001”** (email: registrar@rcb.res.in) by 30th Oct, 2015. List of selected candidates will be displayed on the website of the Centre by 15st Nov, 2015 and the candidates will have to give their acceptance by 30th Nov, 2015, failing which the waitlisted candidates may be considered. The training program will start in January 2016 or earlier as per availability of respective PIs. The decisions of the Executive Director of the Centre will be final in this regard.
