Six-Month Research Training at RCB

Applications are invited for six-month research training from final year graduate and postgraduate science students of Universities/ Institutions/ Colleges for the session commencing from January 2019 (January-June 2019). The terms and conditions will be as follows:

- 1. The candidates must be in final year of graduation or at postgraduate level with strong interest in research.
- 2. The candidates will have to make their own local arrangements for stay and other logistics.
- 3. They will not be entitled to any remuneration, stipend or fellowship/assistance in any form during the training period.
- 4. They will have to abide by the rules of the RCB for the duration of training.
